Dr. Mark W. Presley came to Eastfield College in 1992 to serve as Dean of the Division of Science, Math and Physical Education. He has been in that position for 15 years. Prior to Eastfield he had held positions in both industry and academia. He was on the research staff of the University of Texas at Austin for 4 years and worked in oil and gas exploration for 11 years. Dr. Presley grew up in Atlantic City, NJ and graduated from Atlantic High School (the Vikings) in 1964. He received a AB from Franklin & Marshall College (the Diplomats) in Pennsylvania in 1968 and an MS from the University of Montana (the Grizzlies) in 1971. Both degrees were in geology. After teaching secondary school in the early 1970s, he attended West Virginia University (the Mountaineers) where he received his PhD in geology in 1977.

Dr. Presley and his wife Anne have 5 children and a growing number of grandchildren. In his spare time he loves to "geologize" (travel to geological places and learn more about the sciences), read, hike, write, work with youth and spend time with his family.
