

## ***CASE PRESENTATION QUESTIONS***

### ***POOL OF QUESTIONS***

- Screening:* Describe the purpose of screening and the process used with this client.
- Intake:* Describe the elements of intake and how the intake process was completed in this case.
- Orientation:* Describe the process of orienting this client to your services.
- Assessment:* Describe the methods and procedures used to assess this client and explain the results of those assessments.
- Treatment Planning:* Identify the components of treatment planning and describe the treatment planning process that occurred between you and this client.
- Counseling:* Identify your counseling approaches and theories, and thoroughly describe how you applied them to the client in this case.
- Case Mgt.:* Describe the purpose of case management and how it applied to this client.
- Crisis Intervention:* Give an example of a crisis that occurred in this case and explain how you responded to it. If no crisis occurred, give an example of a crisis using another case?
- Client Education:* What is the purpose of client education and describe how you provided it in this case.
- Referral:* Describe the process of referral and explain how it was used in this case.
- Record Keeping:* Describe the report and record keeping process and how they were used in this case.
- Consultation:* Describe the purpose of consultation and the rationale for and results of consultations necessary in this case. If no consultation occurred, provide an example from another case.
