



CREDIT / CONTINUING EDUCATION
MINIMUM AGE POLICY WAIVER

The following circumstance may constitute grounds for an age waiver in classes where the minimum age is 18 years:

- If a parent/guardian registers in the same class with the student who is less than 18 years of age.
If it is impossible for an adult to register with a student who is less than 18 years of age, or if other age waivers are requested, exceptions may be made under the following circumstances:
1. Instructor must approve waiver.
2. Student and/or parent/guardian must sign a statement acknowledging exceptional status of the student's behavior in the class designed for older persons.
3. The Director reserves the right to terminate the exceptional student's enrollment if the student's classroom behavior is disruptive to the instructor or the students who are of age.
