The Dual Credit program at the colleges of DCCCD offers qualified and motivated high school students as young as grade 9, the opportunity to earn college credit while completing high school. **All Dual Credit classes are FREE** and are taught at the high school or at a college. When you have finished your dual credit classes, they are transferable to all Texas public colleges and universities and to some private and out-of-state institutions, helping you get your degree sooner while saving you money on tuition.

Complete basic college classes designed to transfer to a University or complete a technical certificate **designed to get you a higher wage job right after high school.**

Who Can Enroll?

To participate, students MUST:

Be enrolled in grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 at a participating high school, private charter or home school.

Have approval from a high school counselor.

Complete appropriate admissions criteria for the college.

Meet the minimum test scores that directly apply to the course(s).

Present a passing score on either the ACT, SAT, STAAR or Texas Success Initiative (TSI) Assessment test (reading, writing or math).

How Do I Enroll?

Before enrolling you must review eligibility requirements for the program with your high school counselor. Your counselor will tell you which classes are designated as dual credit at your school.

NEXT Students MUST:

Complete the online admissions application for high school students.

Complete the high school student enrollment form.

Obtain an official high school transcript.

Ensure all required documents are submitted to the Dual Credit office at the college you plan to attend.

Take and/or provide proof of required testing.
